

Election Process for AEC Board of Directors

The Membership of AEC will elect three (3) directors in 2018 to represent districts 1, 2, and 5. These directors will each serve a three-year term. Persons interested in running for director positions on the Appalachian Electric Cooperative Board of Directors may review this document or find additional information at www.aecoop.org.

The general qualifications for the position of director state that individuals must be at least 18 years of age, be in good standing with the Cooperative, and must reside in the AEC district for which he or she is a candidate.

Nominations by Petition will be accepted June 1—July 15, 2018. Any Co-op member who meets the requirements for service and resides in the district that is open for election may collect the signatures of 15 or more members of the cooperative and, acting together, may submit a nomination by petition. The petition may be submitted on or before July 15, 2018 to the office of the General Manager of AEC by Certified US Mail to P. O. Box 400, New Market TN 37820 or by delivery to 1109 Hill Drive, New Market TN 37820.

All nominations for election will be posted publicly by the Nominating Committee no later than July 31, 2018. The 2018 Annual Membership Meeting is set for September 29, 2018. An announcement of the election and voting process will be announced by AEC between August 1 and September 28, 2018. All members in good standing are eligible to cast a vote in these director elections.
